

Research Update:

CTBC Asset Management Co. Ltd. Ratings Affirmed At 'twA+/twA-1'; Outlook Stable

Rating Action

Taiwan Ratings Corp. today affirmed its 'twA+' long term ratings and 'twA-1' short term issuer credit ratings on **CTBC Asset Management Co. Ltd.** (CTBC AMC). The outlooks on the long-term rating is stable.

Rationale

The affirmation reflect the implicit support from the company's financially stronger parent, CTBC Financial Holding Co. Ltd. group, It also reflects the asset management company's very strong capitalization on a consolidated basis and adequate funding and liquidity supported by the group. Counterbalancing factors include the limited scale and operating performance of CTBC AMC's business in Taiwan as well as in China through its leasing entity, CTBC Leasing. CTBC AMC faces higher economic risks compared with other Taiwan-based non-bank financial institutions, which are mostly locally based, given CTBC AMC's sizable risk exposure in China on a consolidated basis.
