First Life Insurance Co. Ltd. Ratings Affirmed At 'twAA-'; Outlook Stable

Rating Action

Taiwan Ratings Corp. today affirmed its 'twAA-' long-term insurer financial strength and issuer credit ratings on First Life Insurance Co. Ltd. The outlook on the ratings is stable. The ratings reflect our view of strong support from its parent, First Financial Holding Co. Ltd. group, given our assessment of the insurer's highly-strategic group status. The ratings also reflect the insurer's high linkage to the group's wider customer resources and the insurer's adequate investment risk profile. Counterbalancing factors include First Life's relatively small scale in the domestic life insurance market, as well as marginal capital and earnings relative to its risk profile.
