

Research Update:

Ratings On Taiwan Sugar Corp. Affirmed At 'twAA/twA-1+'; Outlook Stable

March 17, 2025

Rating Action Rationale

Taiwan Ratings Corp. today affirmed its 'twAA' long-term and 'twA-1+' short-term issuer credit ratings on **Taiwan Sugar Corp.** The outlook on the long-term rating is stable. The ratings reflect the company's large low-cost land bank for development and disposal, sustainable and stable rental income, and prudent financial policy with a net cash position. However, the weak profitability of its non-land related businesses, including sugar and hogs raising businesses partly offset the company's rating strengths.

The ratings on Taiwan Sugar continue to reflect our view of the moderately high likelihood of extraordinary financial support from the Taiwan government, given the company is almost entirely government-owned. That's despite the company has a limited policy role providing stability in the domestic staple goods markets.
